**Casablanca, february 21, 2019** - Attijariwafa bank group and its Africa Development Club of are organizing the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of the International Africa Development Forum, on March 14<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup>,2019, in Casablanca.

Held under the High Patronage of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, may God assist Him, this edition under the theme «When East meets West» addresses regional integration and growth issues of the continent.

- How to reposition African youth at the heart of action and value creation? with the participation of Mr. Thierry Breton, ATOS CEO and Mr. Tomi Davies, President of the African Business Angels Network (Nigeria),
- **«Stand Up for African Women Entrepreneurs» (SUFAWE)** with the participation of Ms. Achamyelesh Ashenafi, President of the Addis Ababa Women Entrepreneurs Association (Ethiopia) and Ms. Alicia Hammond, Gender Specialist at the World Bank,
- The «Positive Impact», guarantor of solidarity and responsible growth with the participation of Mr. Hassan Ouriagli, Chief Executive Officer of Al Mada and Mr. Lionel Zinsou, Founder and Managing Partner of SouthBridge.
- **2. Participating in previously organized B to B meetings** to identify concrete development levers and generate partnerships.
- **3. Participating in the Investment Market** where 8 countries are honored for this edition, by the invitation of official delegations to present national development plans and investment project banks. The eight countries are:
